Each ballot paper, however returned to the school, should be in a plain sealed envelope, which in turn is inside a sealed envelope, which has the name of the parent voting (and their child(ren)s name who are at the school) written on the outside. This 'double envelope' system is necessary so that those voting can then be checked against the school register as a way of ensuring that only those entitled to take part in the ballot actually do so and the ballot remains secret.
