









Reading one picture book to your child every day introduces them to 78,000 words every year.






English alphabetic code

- Over 150+ graphemes (letter combinations)


One of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.








Read Write Inc. Phonics – information for parents

- 4. Read stories to your child every day


