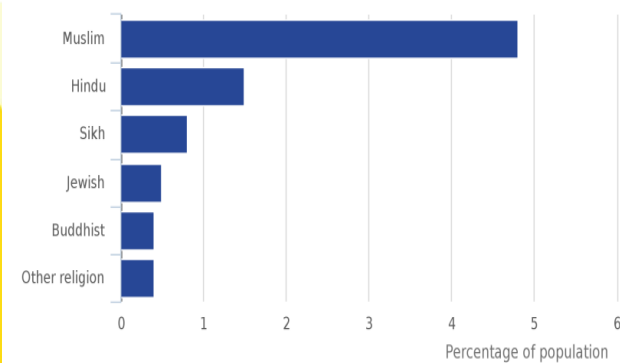
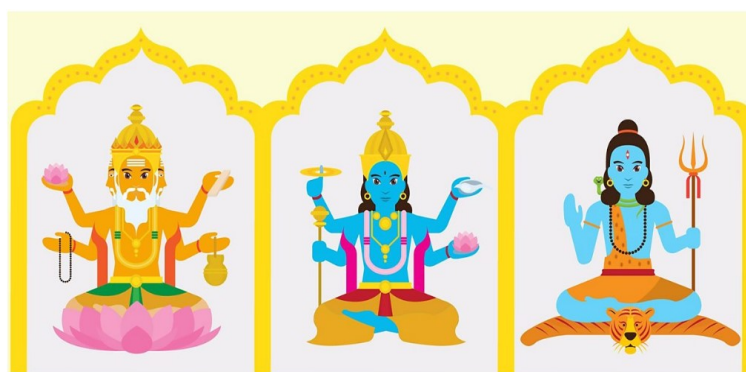
**Important facts**

- There are currently over 1 million people living in the UK that are Hindu.
- Hindus believe in a cycle of reincarnation, where a person will come back to life as an animal or go across to Moksha (a place of paradise).
